Brother Fredrick J. Weitkamp (Ross Chapter) served as Executive Director of Phi Alpha Delta from 1952 to 1992. During this period of his service to the Fraternity, the number of chapters increased from 45 to 172, and total membership increased from 30,000 to 140,000. He organized and directed 21 international Conventions of the Fraternity. He and his son John F. Weitkamp (Ford Chapter) were partners in the law firm of Weitkamp & Weitkamp located in Granada Hills, CA for 30 years. He and Brother Matthew S. Rae are tied for the most consecutive PAD Conventions attended - 32 each. Fred bled purple and gold, and he was committed to bring scholarship, leadership and educational opportunities for his fellow P.A.D. brothers and sisters. Brother Weitkamp passed away in 2018, leaving behind an incomparable legacy in Phi Alpha Delta.

- Be a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident or eligible Non-U.S. citizen

- Have plans to attend the 2020 Biennial Convention and National Leadership Conference

This grant is for one Convention Registration based on double occupancy (arrival August 5, 2020 and departure August 8, 2020) is not transferrable or otherwise redeemable. \$300 will be applied to the registration fee. Upon confirmation of hotel or transportation booking, an additional \$200 may be awarded to the recipient to cover travel costs.
